

ARTICLE XII : Endorsements

Candidates for elected office seeking an endorsement of the North NJ DSA Chapter must submit a completed candidate questionnaire through the chapter's Electoral Working Group (EWG). Upon completion of the candidate questionnaire, a candidate who seeks the chapter's endorsement shall attend an Electoral Working Group meeting for a candidate interview.

Following the candidate's completed questionnaire, candidate interview by the Electoral Working Group, and upon consent from the EWG, candidates may be moved on to the general membership for full consideration of an endorsement at the next general chapter meeting once 30 days has passed from the formal announcement to the membership for a comment and review period. At this point, a candidate may attend a general membership meeting for consideration of an endorsement, but this is not a requirement for endorsement. A candidate must receive a $\frac{2}{3}$ majority vote by responding members in good standing during the open voting period at a NNJ DSA Chapter Meeting with a quorum of 5% of all members in good standing fulfilled.
