Short-term include legislation preventing new ICE contracts and renewals (already in Assembly), commitments to phase out county contracts, ending transfers of people from law enforcement to ICE, waves of releases of people currently detained. Long-term include abolition of ICE in NJ, dissolution of detention centers full-stop, permanent protected status for immigrants in NJ.

How will you bring in new members to the DSA and develop new leaders? How will you engage our existing members in the work? *

Engaging people through phone calls and conversations at their doors (if possible) or following-up based on door-hanging notices. Having people engaged lead door-hanging/canvass launches and phonebanks. Sharing stories of directly impacted people, offering media and leadership space for them to be centered.
